**Painting supplies are listed in order of importance!
Any painting supplies already owned by student can be used
instead of suggested supplies. Provided that the student is
familiar with its performance.**

Oil Painting Supply List

1. Folder for Handouts
2. Spiral Note-book
3. **Student or Gallery Canvas- 8x10, 11x14 or 16x20**-If possible no canvas board, unless you already have some. Only purchase a stretch canvas. Remember you are going to be putting much time and effort into your work. You want your art work to remain stable.
4. **Brushes-** Purchase long-handled or short sable blends, or synthetic sable. **Square Tip Flats or Brights**, preferable to Rounds or Filberts
Brush Sizes- 4, 8, 12, 14 or 16

*** Your Brushes are extremely important in the execution of your work***

Clean up and brush care note:

Your brushes are one of your most important and expensive investments. The cleaning and conditioning of your brushes after use is essential. Neglecting your brushes will cause them to fan out and quickly become useless. You will want to first rinse out any oil paint from your brushes with vegetable oil and then gently wipe them with a rag. Thoroughly, but gently wash brushes with shampoo and carefully wipe them dry with a rag. You want to condition them by applying a small amount of Vaseline. Wipe any excess with a rag and gently flatten the bristles with your finger.

- . Raw Sienna
- . Burnt Sienna

- . Cobalt Blue
- . Cerulean Blue

Greens

- . Sap Green
- . Viridian

Reds

- . Rose Madder
- . Cadmium Red

* Many of these colors are available as hues which are less expensive. I will provide some paints. If possible, purchase a small personal set to enable yourself to experiment and paint at home if you are motivated.*
